SITUATION	PESTS	HOW TO APPLY
Citrus	Ants, black citrus aphid (not TAS), thrips	Apply when infestations are first noticed & then at weekly intervals while insects are active. Shake well before use. Spray directly onto insects and surrounding foliage including the under surfaces of leaves. Hold the bottle 25cm from the plants & apply in a sweeping motion.
Indoor & Outdoor plants (including ornamental plants, roses and shrubs).	Ants, aphids, caterpillars, greenhouse whitefly, leafhoppers, thrips.	
Vegetables	Aphids, budworm, caterpillars, leafhoppers, thrips.

[Sprayer Instructions]

***No hand fatigue! Continuous spray** *[for battery powered sprayer only]*

**[For battery powered sprayer only]*

1. Remove Comfort Wand™ from side clip. Unwrap hose completely.
2. Remove protective slip from battery compartment to activate batteries.
3. Insert red plug at end of hose into white spout on cap until it clicks. Flip up spout. Spout must remain upright while spraying.
4. Flip open Comfort Wand™ until it locks into position. Twist nozzle at end of Comfort Wand™ to desired spray pattern.
5. Point sprayer away from body. Ensure trigger lock is disengaged before spraying. Hold white trigger for continuous spray. Release trigger to stop spray. Hold spray nozzle at least 30cm from plant foliage.

AFTER USE: Twist nozzle to the off position. Engage trigger lock. Flip the Comfort Wand™ closed and store on the side clip.

IMPORTANT: Do not submerge in water. When storing sprayer for long periods, remove batteries.

TO REPLACE BATTERIES: Open battery compartment. Remove used batteries. Insert new batteries. Close compartment.

**[For hand trigger sprayer only]*

1. Remove sprayer. Pull cord ALL THE WAY OUT.
2. Insert red plug into spout (on cap) until it clicks. Shake well before use.
3. Flip spout up. Open nozzle at end of sprayer. Start by pressing the trigger 7 or 8 times.
4. After use close the nozzle. Push the spout down into a horizontal position and replace sprayer in the nested bottle without disconnecting.

**[For alternative hand trigger sprayer only]*

1. Remove safety cap. Attach trigger to mechanism.
2. Turn nozzle to 'open' position. Start by pressing the trigger 7 or 8 times. Adjust nozzle for direct spray or mist spray.
3. Spray plants as required.
4. After use, place safety cap back onto container. To store trigger mechanism, rinse through with water and replace sprayer on side bracket.
