Apply CLIPSHIELD 60 SPRAY ON FOR SHEEP according to the diagram and tables in the Directions for Use. CLIPSHIELD 60 SPRAY ON FOR SHEEP may be applied to all breeds of sheep, providing protection against fly strike. CLIPSHIELD 60 SPRAY ON FOR SHEEP is applied as a lowvolume treatment onto or near the area where protection is required. When applying, the nozzle of the applicator gun should be approximately 25 cm above the fleece, to achieve a 15cm wide band at each pass.
